

- In April 2020, the Chamber Board contacted every Chamber member business to gather information and feedback on COVID-19 concerns.
- Created the Distance Socially, Eat Locally flyer supporting restaurants current status on hours and delivery service.




The business development committee goal is to grow the population in Mahaska County by 5% annually. The graph above gives a snapshot of the current growth trend in comparison to our peer communities.


