
TOURISM

- Participated in Travel Iowa Co-Op Marketing, purchasing digital ad space. Promoted Painting with Lights.
- Partnered with the Mahaska County ISU Extension on the first annual 'Great Iowa Road Trip' event.
- Updated listing in Central Iowa Tourism Magazine.
- Designed and created the 2021 'Explore Mahaska' Visitors' Guide.
- Received \$3,200 grant for marketing from Iowa Tourism.
- Raised funds (\$26,000) for 'Trolley Stop Alley'. Created designs and presented to appropriate committees.
- Created five rack cards with itineraries. These were distributed at the Iowa State Fair.

Iowa Total Visitor Spending Pandemic affects results:

Visitor spending declined 29%; however, visitors to Iowa still spent \$4.6 billion in 2020, which generated \$7.3 billion in total business sales, including indirect and induced impacts.

The pandemic and its various travel restrictions and changes in traveler behavior cut nearly \$1.9 billion from 2019 visitor spending levels.




Mahaska County Spending & Economic Impact




INNOVATION PARK

Oskaloosa, Iowa

The Mahaska Chamber & Development Group in partnership with the City of Oskaloosa and Mahaska County have been invited to Step 3 of the Certified Site application process. We are working with six land owners, 21 parcels, for a total of 499.6 acres to be certified.

- Applied for and received \$75,600 grant from the Iowa Department of Transportation for the Oskaloosa Industrial Park Transload Facility Study. Also received \$4,725 matching grant from MidAmerican Energy, partnering with the City of Oskaloosa and Mahaska County to cover the \$94,500 study cost.
- Continue to work on the Mahaska County US 63 – IA 23 Connector RISE Grant Application in partnership with the City of Oskaloosa and Mahaska County.

Business Retention & Expansion • Recruitment

- Small business media marketing assistance in partnership with the Area15 Regional Planning Commission has assisted 14 businesses for a total value of \$22,280 in service to our small businesses.
- Assisted the City of Fremont with a derelict building grant through the Mahaska County Community Foundation and received \$20,000.
- Partnered with the Small Business Development Center and Mahaska County ISU Extension on a financial seminar for entrepreneurs.
- Organized an industry roundtable to meet quarterly to discuss challenges, successes and community concerns.
- Applied for and received grant funds for the Eddyville Pocket Park in the amount of \$10,000





Mahaska County Wish Book

- Nominated the 2020 Wish Book for the Main Street Iowa Awards and it was reconized state-wide on their virtual awards presentation.
- Promoted the Wish Book in February as a Valentine's shopping guide
- Oskaloosa Main Street promotions committee completed the 2021 Wish Book book which featured 200+ gift ideas. 2,000 copies were printed and distributed around and outside of Mahaska County.

Phase III Downtown Facade

- Partnered with the City of Oskaloosa on the Phase III Downtown Facade program. One of the only communities in Iowa to be awarded grant funds for 3 phases.

Lighted Christmas Parade Economic Impact to the Community

- Estimated 7,200 spectators
- Total of \$104,400 spent in Oskaloosa because of the parade event:
 - \$57,600 travel
 - \$36,000 dining
 - \$8,300 gas
 - \$2,500 lodging
- Thank you to William Penn University students for surveying the crowd and counting parking spaces and cars before and during the event.
- In a sample of 340 cars downtown during the parade, there were 35 counties in Iowa represented.
